





- Suitable for ages 15+
















Objectives of Pilot Program

Increase the proficiency level of English students at Federal Universities

• Create a structured model for teaching English at the Federal Universities for replication to the other IES.

Target Audience

Context:

. The multiplicity of scenarios and realities of students and universities throughout Brazil poses enormous challenges to structuring a single solution that meets all teaching demands.


The Pilot Project seeks to assist initially:

- Students in a situation of socioeconomic vulnerability;
- Students enrolled in Universities and/or Campi that do not have access to language centers;
- Students with proficiency level A1, A2 and/or B1;
 Alternatively B2 and C1.


Structure

- Synchronous remote classes for levels A1 and A2
- Tutoring centers for B1, B2, C1 students
- Hub Universities
- Support Platform: Curriculum and LMS


