- International Experience Canada manages youth mobility agreements between Canada and over 35 countries/territories that facilitate work permits specifically for youth aged 18-35*
- Work permits are for up to two years*
 - *Country-specific agreements and requirements apply



Agreement signed in August 2023 and implemented in January 2024.


Youth will have more options than ever when applying for international travel and work opportunities.





Employment by Region


IEC Employment by Province and Territory (2020)
