



About CAPS-I


- Non-profit association of 130 public (government) school districts*

Distribution of CAPS-I Members in 2023-2024


CAPS-I represents 130 public school boards/districts/divisions








Total International Student Enrolment



Long Term International Student Enrolment




Top 10 source countries for students enrolled for 1 semester or full academic year



Long Term International Student Enrolment




Top 11-20 source countries for students enrolled for 1 semester or full academic year



Short Term International Student Enrolment




Top 10 source countries of students studying for 4 months or less
