What is IELTS?

The 'International English Language Testing System'

Jointly owned by 3 partners:







Extensive collective experience in language testing and delivery internationally

British Council and IDP: IELTS Australia: test delivery

Cambridge Assessment English: test production, development, research and analysis



Test Format

Total test time

2 hours 44 minutes (+ transfer time)



Listening30 minutes,
4 sections, 40 items



Reading
60 minutes,
3 sections, 40 items



Writing
60 minutes,
2 tasks



Speaking 11–14 minutes, 3 parts

The topics are of general interest and it makes no difference what subjects candidates have studied in the past.

IELTS

- Each band corresponds to a level of competence in English.
- All parts of the test and the overall band score are reported in whole or half bands, e.g. 7.0, 8.5.

IELTS scale

- ↑ 9 Expert user
- ↑ 8 Very good user
- ↑ 7 Good user
- ↑ 6 Competent user
- ↑ Modest user
- ↑ Limited user
- ↑ 3 Extremely limited user
- ↑ 2 Intermittent user
- ↑ 1 Non user
- ↑ 0 Did not attempt test



Facts and figures

- Tests administered in 140 + countries and 1,600 + locations worldwide
- Over 3.5 million tests taken last year
- Recognized by 10,000 + organisations in 140 countries
- Results released 13 days after test (5-7 days for computer-delivered IELTS)
- 7,000 + examiners
- Up to 5 TRFs can be sent electronically/paper to receiving organisations
- 2 tests Academic and General Training



Two IELTS tests to meet all purposes

IELTS Academic:

If you're looking to study at a university in Canada at the undergraduate or postgraduate level, or join a professional association where English is a prerequisite.

IELTS General Training:

If you're looking to apply to an immigration program such as Express Entry in order to establish yourself in Canada.






