In the beginning...

2014 Canada-Brazil Forum for Language, Education and the Workforce

"Language is an essential component in the globalizing economies, societies and cultures of our respective countries. It is an essential step toward high-quality education and a productive workforce. When language education is not properly addressed, serious gaps develop in a country's education and labour force internationalization efforts." - Quote from Forum report.

Recommendations:

- Canada-Brazil MOU on language education cooperation;
- Repeat the Forum;
- Integrate language into internationalization policies;
- Create initiative to drive Canadian student to Brazil (with language as foundation)

LC - IsF partnership

Languages Canada - MEC cooperation agreement signed Nov 2015



Purpose: To support the growth of bilateral relations between Canada and Brazil and of language education as a fundamental aspect of the internationalization of education and the workforce.

10 guiding principles, rooted in integration of language education and internationalization; quality; inclusivity; and a collaborative, long-term, mutually beneficial approach.



LC - IsF partnership projects

English / French language teachers' assistant certificate and student mobility pilot project



Goals:

- Enhance and incentivize student mobility between Canada and Brazil;
- Build capacity for English and French language education delivery in Brazil;
- Increase Portuguese language education opportunities for Canadian students; and
- Support internationalization through institutional partnerships.

Preliminary meeting in Ottawa with LC members (Oct 16, 2017)





English / French language teachers' assistant certificate

Objective: To establish an internationally-recognized, online certificate course that will qualify Canadian postsecondary students to serve as an <u>assistant</u> to teachers of English or French as a second language, in foreign (primarily Brazilian) classroom settings.

Development of Certificate course content, technical design, hosting and administration will be conducted by (a team of) project partners, made up of committed LC members, that will be selected through a juried competitive process.





Student mobility pilot project

Goal: To implement three to five pilot projects between LC and IsF member universities/colleges which integrate the following components:

- Canadian college/university student mobility experience in Brazil, involving: 1)
 academic study and/or research placement; 2) serving as teachers' assistant in English
 and/or French language classrooms; and 3) learning Portuguese through the
 Portuguese for Foreigners stream.
- Participating Canadian students must complete teachers' assistant certificate.
- Creation of incentives within Canadian home college/university to acknowledge the experience in Brazil.
- Commitment by participating institutions to integrate language education into broader academic and research cooperation.
- Reciprocal mobility of Brazilian students to Canada.





English / French language teachers' assistant certificate and student mobility pilot project

Next steps / timeline:

- Establish Advisory Committee 10 representation from IsF federal and state members, LC public, private, university and college members; private sector; alumnus; other stakeholders
- Call for proposal for certificate design/delivery (March 2018)
- Confirm 4-5 pilot project partners (e.g. Universidade Federal de Uberlândia -Algonquin College)
- Launch of certificate course (Summer-fall 2018)
- Launch of pilot projects (Summer-fall 2018)

- 3. Implementation of academic courses taught in English

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
